Her minimalist, modern, attractive exterior separates the Fjord 40 Open from other motor yachts. She is Fjord Boats' first model in a brand-new line of motor yachts. Designers and naval architects surrounding award-winning designer Patrick Banfield concentrated on the essential: A fast hull, an extremely generous deck layout and a comfortable interior that stands out in this class of motor boats.

The results have already convinced many customers. The IPS-drive with its twin Volvo diesel engines accelerates the boat to 44 knots. The additional joystick makes the yacht's maneuverability child's play in port.

The deck is teak all around offering an area of more than 10 sqm. of outdoor relaxation. The dual purpose eating and sitting area has space for up to 12 people and can easily be turned into a sun bed. No other motor yacht in this class offers more sun deck.
