Hanse 320 & Hanse 350

THE GERMAN yard recently introduced two entry-level models in terms of size to its growing range. The Judel/Vrolijk designs come with "modern T speed keels" and the company's trademark self-tacking jib setup, with a single-line reefing system and simplified mainsail handling, with coachroof-mounted

sheeting. All good features for an entry-level model. Interiors have also been reworked on these smaller boats with the 350 head in the bow area, to maximise space, with separate entrance to the saloon. The 350 also has more beam and waterline than the 342 predecessor.
