

HANSE 430e

The 430e, designed by Judel/Vrolijk and built using epoxy resins, is a modern, fast cruiser intended to be easily handled by a small crew. The rig features a large main and self-tacking jib although a genoa is an option. Unusual features of the yacht include an open transom. There are twin steering wheels, all hatches are flush with the decks and control lines are led under the deck to give a clean profile. Down below the joinery can be in Hanse's traditional mahogany or ultra-light cherry finish. Both feature white bulkheads to brighten the interior and increase the feeling of space. The layout features an en suite owner's cabin forward and a choice of cabins aft – a large double or twin bunks. There is a second heads aft, a galley and a saloon in contemporary style.
